The booklet project has been funded by Worcestershire Community Foundation in partnership with the Police and Crime Commissioner.

This project supports our members in building their relationships, confidence and independence through our events and workshops.

With this funding we are hoping to employ someone to concentrate on fundraising and working towards Our Way Self Advocacy becoming less reliant on large grants.

We will be running some workshops to support our members to work on their budgeting skills and we hope to work with other organisations and banks to gain the skills and knowledge in order to do this.
